Health & Safety Statement

Moss Adams takes the health and safety of our people and clients very seriously. Moss Adams will adhere to all CDC guidance as well as federal, state, and local government and/or venue regulations. If requirements change, we'll update the guidance below.

Before Leaving Home

- Follow relevant guidance provided by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) or your local health authority.
- Adhere to government issued restrictions and guidance issued by the region you'll be traveling to and from.
- Evaluate your own health and that of the people you're in close contact with. If there's a risk or if you feel unwell, stay home and if necessary, seek medical treatment.
- Please **do not** attend the event if you exhibit any symptoms associated with COVID-19 or have been in close contact with someone who tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 14 days.

On-Site During the Event

- If you feel unwell, **do not** attend the event and seek medical treatment.
- Should masks be required, masks must be well-fitting, non-ventilated, cloth masks (gaiters, bandanas, face-shield only do not qualify) worn over the nose and mouth.
- Ask before physically touching other attendees (i.e., handshakes, hugs, fist bumps) and respect their level of comfort with physical proximity.
- Event protocols on entry/exit areas, directional movement, etc. must be followed.
- Avoid gathering in groups.
- If possible, move outdoors for conversations.
- Follow guidance from your local health authority for everyday preventative actions to help prevent the spread of viruses, including:
 - Wash hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or with an alcoholbased sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol.
 - Avoid touching your face.
 - \circ $\;$ Maintain a comfortable and reasonable distance from others.
- All event areas have been designed to provide ample space for attendees to move around safely. If capacity or gathering restrictions are in effect, venue spaces and/or attendee counts will adhere to those limits.
- All Moss Adams employees will adhere to the guidance from the CDC and local authorities.
