

Through Foundation donations and matching funds via the GiveBack program, we supported a range of philanthropic groups, educational initiatives, relief efforts, and other worthy causes, such as the arts and social justice organizations.

GIVEBACK PROGRAM

Our GiveBack program provides an opportunity for our people to support the institutions and causes they care about.

Through the program, employees and partners are eligible for 100% matching for donations to our approved universities; employees are eligible for up to \$500 per year in matching for donations to thousands of charitable organizations.

Since 2018, the first full year of our GiveBack program, we've made significant progress.



UNITED IN CHANGE

Despite the uncertainty brought on by a worldwide pandemic, monumental social justice initiatives, and historic wildfires, our people came together for firmwide giving campaigns.

Our efforts, which included our annual Giving Tuesday drive and disaster relief efforts, culminated in unprecedented participation and record-breaking generosity from our people. We're extremely proud of the results from our four firmwide campaigns.

Additionally, 2020 marked the first year the Moss Adams Foundation and firm came together for a special giving campaign in support of a social justice cause. Through our Embracing Equity and Justice for Black Americans campaign, we stood with the Black Lives Matter (BLM) movement and exceeded our goal of raising more than **\$100,000** for three Black-led organizations fighting systemic racism in the United States:
